Our commitment to you on how we handle your complaint



We take each complaint seriously and will work with you to find an outcome that is fair and which meets our obligations under the law.



We will provide information about our complaint handling process, the timeframes that apply and the progress of your complaint.



If you are hearing impaired, we can use the National Relay Service to relay your conversation with a member of our team.

If you're experiencing financial hardship, health challenges, or other personal circumstances that make it difficult to engage with us, Hume Bank offers additional support to assist you. If you require extra help or adjustments, please let us know. Your information will be handled confidentially, and you will not be treated unfairly for requesting support.

We aim to resolve your complaint within 24 hours or 1 business day and will ensure we stay in contact during all stages of the complaint. We may do this by contacting you by phone or providing a written update.

For any complaint that is resolved after 5 business days (or if you request it), we will provide to you in writing the outcome and resolution of the complaint for your records. We will always provide a written response if your complaint relates to hardship.

If we have not been able to resolve your complaint within 21 days, we will write to you and advise of the reason for delay, and provide the contact details to escalate your concern to an external dispute resolution scheme (if you choose). On the rare occasion that the complaint can't be resolved by 30 days, we will write to you again.

How to make a complaint

You can reach out to us in one of the following ways:



Visit a branch

In most cases, we can resolve your complaint on the spot at your local branch. If we can't, your complaint will be logged and escalated.



Call us

Call 1300 004 863 to chat with one of our team who can have your concern sorted out as soon as possible.



Online form

Complete our complaints form, then you can expect to hear from us within two business days to sort things out.

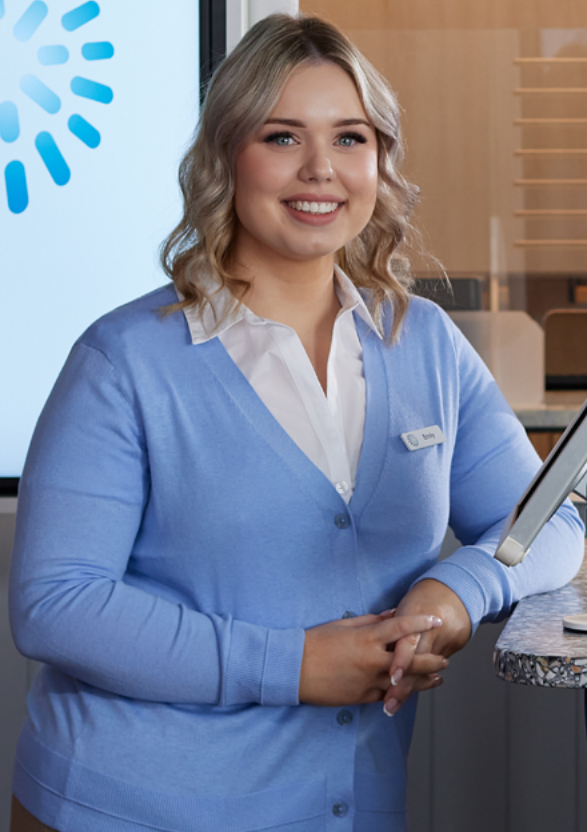


Send a message

Go to your inbox on the Hume Bank App or iBank and press 'new message'.

What we need to know about your complaint.

1. Information about you like your name and contact details.
2. We need to gather from you the nature of your concern, understand how we fell short of your expectations, and how you would like us to resolve your complaint.
3. Depending on the type of the complaint, we may ask you to provide some additional information or documentation to help us understand your concern – but we'll let you know if this is the case.

What to expect from us

When we receive a complaint, we take each complaint seriously, and will work with you to find an outcome that is fair, and which meets our obligations under the law.

If we cannot resolve your concern on the spot (or receive your complaint through our website or by letter), the complaint is escalated to our Customer Support Department for review and investigation. You will receive an acknowledgment from us when this occurs.

You can expect us to contact you within two business days to discuss your concern in more detail and agree on the best way to resolve the complaint.



Not satisfied with the outcome of your complaint?

If you are not satisfied with the outcome of your complaint, or it remains unresolved, you have the option to escalate your concern to the following external bodies:
